Owning a pet means committing to their well-being for potentially over 15 years. It requires financial stability to cover medical expenses, potential relocations, and ensuring your accommodation is pet-friendly. Additionally, life changes such as marriage or having kids shouldn't lead to abandoning your furry friend.

Regular exercise is vital, with a minimum of two walks a day being necessary. While we provide behavior analysis for our dogs, many have experienced trauma, so being prepared to provide training and work with specialists is essential if behavioral issues arise.

We firmly believe that our dogs deserve to be part of a loving family and should live indoors, not relegated to the backyard or other outdoor arrangements. By adopting a pet, you're making a lifelong commitment to their happiness and well-being.

And trust us, the gratitude and happy moments that will be added to your life will be worth the effort you're making.

That's when I learned what trust feels like.


She rescued us together. I was scared in the car, but Marley kept me brave. Now, I live in a shelter, still with Marley.

I can't wait for the day where I get to eat my favourite treats on a sofa in my very own forever home!






Hello, I'm Lucky , 🐾 🤎

I still get nervous sometimes, but I'm starting to trust. Starting to believe this could be what home feels like.


I'm waiting for my forever person — someone who'll see past the barking and understand I'm just a young dog trying his best. I don't need perfect. Just someone who'll stay.

I'm still young, super friendly, and get along well with everyone I meet. All I need now is a family to call my own. Could that be you?









Almond was adopted quickly—she's already home.


I'm now in a loving foster home, learning that not all humans leave. They say I'm brave. That I matter. That someone out there is looking for a puppy just like me.



My name is Alpha. I'm ready to love, and I'm ready to be loved.



I'm not a reputation.
















Hi, I'm Nadya, a Saluki girl with a quiet heart and a long story.


He couldn't keep us, so he gently asked us to get out.


We were cold, hungry, and alone. I curled around my babies, trying to keep them warm. I didn't cry. I just hoped.

I'm Bianca. I may have been abandoned, but I haven't given up. I'm still full of love, and I'm ready to give it to someone who will never let me go again.











The kind lady says I'm waiting for my forever home. But now, I wait with hope—because I know what love feels like and I'm starting to trust these humans.





Alternatively, if there is no invoice for the adopted dog, we appreciate a small contribution towards our medical expenses at the clinic. A vet invoice will be provided for transparency."

The dog will be dropped off by the rescuer for a home check and a two-week trial. If everything goes well, the adoption is completed, and the pet passport can be collected from the clinic.

1. Providing all necessary expenses for food, supplies, and veterinary care to ensure the dog's health and well-being.

2. Transporting the dog as needed, including driving to veterinary appointments or other necessary destinations.

3. Actively seeking out potential adopters and facilitating meetings between them and the foster dog.

4. Arranging all logistics related to the adoption process, including paperwork, home visits, and follow-up appointments.

5. Providing ongoing support and guidance to both the foster dog and potential adopters throughout the fostering and adoption process.


Your Responsibility
